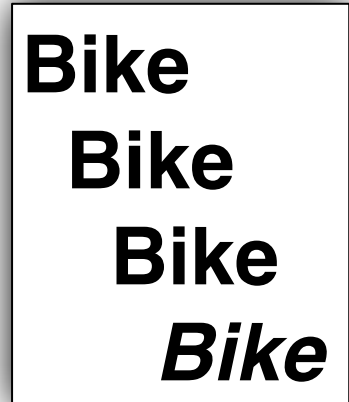

DIRECTIONS TO HIGLEY FLOW STATE PARK:

FROM POTSDAM- South on state route 56 through Hannawa Falls, Colton and South Colton. Cross the bridge over the Raquette River, take 1st right on Cold Brook Dr. 1.5 miles to park, turn right on park access road. Go 0.1 mile, turn right into Lodge parking lot.

FROM CANTON- Take state route 68 to Colton, turn right on state route 56, take 56 through South Colton, cross the bridge over the Raquette, turn right on Cold Brook Dr., 1.5 miles to park. Turn right on park access road, go 0.1 mile, turn right into Lodge parking lot.

FROM TUPPER LAKE- Take route 3 west to Sevey's Corners, then north on 56 to South Colton, turn left on Cold Brook Dr. before the bridge over the Raquette river. Follow Cold Brook Dr. 1.5 miles to park. Turn right following park road. Go 0.1 mile, turn right into Lodge parking lot.

This event will begin and end at beautiful Higley Flow State Park in the scenic Adirondack foothills. The park is situated off Cold Brook Dr. in South Colton and borders the Raquette River. Register at Higley Trails Lodge - inside the park on the right shortly after you pass the entrance booth. For those not participating in the ride, the park offers 7.8 miles of hiking trails. Additionally there are several shorter loops ranging from 2-25 miles which family members and friends may enjoy riding while their century riders are on the course. The well known Stone Valley hiking trail, bordering cascading waterfalls along the Raquette River, is only four miles from the park.

Proceeds from these events support the efforts of the Friends of Higley Flow State Park to enhance park facilities and services, including the "Higley Trails Lodge" year-round multi-use structure.

PARTICULARS OF THE EVENT

Start times: 100 kilometer ride - **8:30 a.m.**; 50 km. ride - **10:00 a.m.**

Map and commemorative wear pick up is from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the Lodge. A buffet BBQ will be served between 1:00 to 3:30 p.m. for registered participants. Participants may purchase a commemorative tee shirt **if preregistered by Aug. 31**. You will be required to sign an insurance waiver at the time of the map pick up. Each participant will receive a map and cue sheet of the ride. The courses will also be marked on the pavement. A sag wagon will sweep the courses. A water stop will be set up at a mid-point, and roadside stores offer other refreshment stops.

Riders will leave the park and follow mainly a mixture of rural town and county roads. The rides offer some of the best scenery in the area. The area is primarily rural but does pass through several small towns. We think you will find the routes challenging but attractive. Bicycle helmets are required.
